原住民考古與田野考古

二、課程概要

本課程將包含台灣原住民地景的考古田野研究方法,並於環山部落進行為期兩周的田野調查,我們將介紹學生田野研究方法,並與環山部落的當地人民合作進行實作。為期兩週的田野調查中,學生將學習如何進行考古田野研究,並藉由撰寫及公開發表和積極參與推廣活動來分享他們的研究成果。 田野課程將被分成不同的活動來達成本課程的目標。活動包含實地測量及地表測繪,也可能包含遺址區域之試掘,以及在田野地中處理文物和實驗分析。每天傍晚會舉行課程與討論來引導學生完成其研究計畫。

1. Course Name: Issues in Indigenous Archaeology and Introduction to Field Archaeology

2. Course Introduction:

An archaeological field methods class that focuses on indigenous landscapes in Taiwan will accompany the seminar. We will conduct a two-week field survey of the Sqoyaw terraces, introducing students to field methodology and working directly with Sqoyaw community stakeholders. Students participating in the two-week field survey will learn how to conduct archaeological field research; share the results of their studies by writing research papers and doing public presentations; and, by actively being involved in public outreach activities. The field season will be divided into blocks of activities, geared toward achieving the goals of the project. Activities will focus on site survey and surface mapping but may include mortuary and shell midden excavations, processing of artifacts while in the

field, and laboratory analyses. Lectures and discussions will be held every evening to guide students to complete their research projects.
