Awakening News Networks (2010/12/14) Research, Development and Evaluation Commission, Executive Yuan, released the result of the digital divide survey this year, pointing out that, after the commission's promotion of the free loan of wireless-internet accessible computers in the remote districts, the internet usage rate in the remote district has grown up to 57.5%, yet still dropping 15 % behind the non-remote areas.

According to this year's survey, the urbanization degree and the internet/computer usage rate are in direct proportion. Among the cities and counties in Taiwan, Taipei City, Taichung City and Hsinchu City are the most digitalized districts, while Pingtung County, Yunlin County and Chiayi Chouty are the less digitalized (
