NCKU News (2012/12/28) A delegation of 7 representatives of China's Lanzhou University headed by President Xu-Hong ZHOU, visited National Cheng Kung University (NCKU), southern Taiwan, December 27, to strengthen the partnership between NCKU and Lanzhou University and to envision the prospect of future collaborations.

NCKU had signed Momentum of Understanding (MOU) with the College of Literature, Lanzhou University, in 2011, to initiate a 5-year collaboration project, promoting the academic collaboration on Chinese Literature, according to Yuh-Neu CHEN, Vice Dean of College of Liberal Arts.
