[\[PHP\] Case-insensitive in_array\(\) funciton \(without foreach\)](#)

For a case-insensitive in_array(), you can use array_map() to avoid a foreach statement, e.g.:

```
<?php
    function in_arrayi($needle, $haystack) {
        return in_array(strtolower($needle), array_map('strtolower', $haystack));
    }
?>
```
